(for 2020 intake and onwards)**

**1. Preamble**

The PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences, Universiti Brunei Darussalam offers the Bachelor of Health Science (BHSc) degree with a choice of six Majors: Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Biomedical Science, Nursing and Midwifery. The Bachelor of Health Science was offered from August 2009. These regulations apply to the Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing/Midwifery).

**2. Admission Requirements**

To enroll in Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing/Midwifery) applicants must satisfy the following entry requirements:

- a) A minimum of 220 'A' Level points for three 'A' Level passes from Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics or Physics. Other subjects may also be considered on a case by case basis;

OR

an internationally recognised degree of second class honours in a relevant discipline from Universiti Brunei Darussalam or any other university recognised by the University Senate;

OR

an International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma with a score of 26 points, with a minimum of 5,5, 4 in relevant subjects at higher level. (Accepted subjects will be assessed on a case by case basis)

OR

a recognised Higher National Diploma in Sciences or National Diploma in Sciences or its equivalent with a minimum of 5 merits in related subject. (Accepted subjects will be assessed on case by case basis).

OR

(not applicable for the 2020 academic year intake)

a Diploma in Health Science (Nursing or Midwifery or Paramedic) from Politeknik Brunei without work experience with qualification equivalent to Universiti Brunei Darussalam degree classification of upper second class honours (2.1) and above, and a completion of the Diploma with no repeat modules. This will be subject to yearly review. A two year articulated Post-Registration BHSc Nursing/Midwifery programme is designed for these applicants.

OR

(not applicable for the 2020 academic year intake)

a Diploma in Health Science (Nursing or Midwifery or Paramedic) from Politeknik Brunei without work experience with qualification equivalent to Universiti Brunei Darussalam degree classification of lower second class (2.2), and a completion of the Diploma with no repeat modules. This will be subject to yearly review. A three year articulated Post-Registration BHSc Nursing/Midwifery programme is designed for these applicants.

OR

(not applicable for the 2020 academic year intake)

a Diploma in Nursing or Midwifery or Paramedic with or without Post Basic or Advanced Diploma in Nursing or Midwifery or similar qualification with at least two (2) years work experience in their respective field. These applicants will be eligible to join the two year articulated Post-Registration BHSc Nursing/Midwifery programme.

b) English language requirements

At least a credit six in English Language at GCE 'O' Level or a grade 'C' in IGCSE English (as a Second Language) or an IELTS score of 6.0 or better OR TOEFL minimum overall score of 550.

c) Interview

Have performed to a satisfactory standard in a multiple mini-interview (MMI) covering the pre-requisite nursing knowledge, attitudes, ethics and critical skills needed to follow this programme.

d) Medical Fitness

Successful candidates are required to go through prescribed medical fitness examination and must be certified as fit to follow the Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing) programme.

### 3. Admissions Policy

- 3.1** For admission to the Bachelor of Health Science programme, a candidate must satisfy the admission requirements of the Universiti Brunei Darussalam as set out in the Admission Regulations of the University and such other special requirements of the PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences as may be specified for the programme and the University Examination regulations for First Degree programmes.
- 3.2** The choice of major must be clearly stated at the time of application. Combinations such as Double Degree or Joint Major or Double Major or Major/Minor as set up in the Generation Next Regulations are permitted depending on the availability of programmes. Entry into such programmes will be dependent upon recommendation by the Programme Leaders, and the assessment and approval of the Deans from all the faculties involved. This is governed by the Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulations.

### 4. Programme Structure

#### 4.1 Programme Structure for BHSc (Nursing)

The BHSc Nursing intake 2020 will immediately be migrated into the new programme structure of intake 2021 from the second year onwards

## 5. Graduation Requirements

### 5.1 Degree Requirements for BHSc (Nursing)

Students must accumulate a minimum of 160 modular credits from a combination of major core, major option & breadth modules as specified in the Programme structure. Detailed programme structure for BHSc (Nursing) intake 2020 is attached in Schedule A. Detailed programme structure for BHSc (Nursing) intake 2021 is attached in Schedule B.

### 5.2 Degree requirements for BHSc (Midwifery)

Students must accumulate a minimum of 160 modular credits from a combination of major core, major option & breadth modules as specified in the Programme structure. Detailed programme structure for BHSc (Midwifery) intake 2020 is attached in Schedule C. Detailed programme structure for BHSc (Midwifery) intake 2021 is attached in Schedule D.

### 5.3 Major Requirements

5.3.1 Students majoring in Nursing must accumulate a total minimum of 86 modular credits of major core for BHSc (Nursing) and 10 modular credits of major option modules except for the case of those who do a double major.

5.3.2 Students majoring in Midwifery must accumulate a total minimum of 86 modular credits of major core for BHSc (Midwifery) and 10 modular credits of major option modules except for the case of those who do a double major.

#### 5.4 Breadth Requirements

- a) Students must accumulate a minimum of 64 modular credits for breadth modules, including modules taken in the Discovery Year (32 modular credits).
- b) At least 16 modular credits will have to be taken from outside the Faculty including general education (GE) modules, of which at least 4 modular credits must be taken from Non-science or Technology faculty (Refer to the Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulation 2013).
- c) Students have to take the following modules as compulsory breadth:
  - i. Communication Modules (8 modular credits)
  - ii. MIB (4 modular credits)
  - iii. Islamic Civilization and the Modern World (4 modular credits)

#### 5.5 Minor Requirements

- a) The Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing) and Bachelor of Health Science (Midwifery) programmes does not offer minor to students from other faculties.
- b) Students registered to major Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing) and Bachelor of Health Science (Midwifery) can register for a minor in other faculties as specified in Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulation 2013.

### 6. Double Major Requirements

Students are allowed to do a double major in Nursing and Midwifery to broaden their knowledge and skills, with a significant degree of depth in both disciplines. Students should declare their double major by the end of semester three and follow the GenNEXT Rules and regulations (length of programme, cGPA minimum).

#### 6.1. Programme Structure for BHSc Nursing and Midwifery (Double Major)

BHSc students majoring in Nursing and Midwifery need to take a total of 184 modular credits. The breakdowns of the modular credits are:

## 6.2. Graduation Requirements

Students are required to read a combination of depth and breadth modules. In addition, there may be specific Faculty and programme requirements that a student must fulfil in order to graduate. Students will be expected to complete 184 modular credits to satisfy the requirements for graduation for a Double Major in Nursing and Midwifery Programme.

In addition, a student must fulfil all university, faculty, programme, Discovery Year and breadth requirements to graduate (for details, please refer to the University Examination Regulations).

Students who are not successful to graduate with a double major can still graduate with a single major provided they fulfill requirements of the single major.

## 6.3 For the students from other faculties outside PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences

PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences will not offer a 2<sup>nd</sup> major in Nursing/Midwifery.

## 7. Double Degree Requirements

### 7.1 For the students from PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences

BHSc students will also be allowed to take a second degree from another faculty. They will have to meet the admission requirements for the second degree specified by the respective faculty. To complete the double degree requirement students need to take as follows:

- a) 96 modular credits of major core and major option modules as specified by the BHSc (Nursing) OR 96 modular credits of major core and major option modules as specified by the BHSc (Midwifery) programme structure.
- b) The required modular credits (or as specified by the other respective faculty) of major core modules for the other degree requirement.
- c) Breadth modules and Discovery Year as specified in the Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulation 2013.

### 7.2 For the students from other science faculties outside PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences



Students from outside PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences will be offered Bachelor of Health Science as a second degree majoring in Nursing/Midwifery subject to a GPA of at least 3.5 in their first two semesters. To complete the double degree requirement students need as follows:

- a) They must meet the admission requirements for the Bachelor of Health Science stated in Clause 2 of this rules and regulations.
- b) 96 modular credits major core and major option modules as specified by the specific BHSc (Nursing) programme OR 96 modular credits major core and major option modules as specified by the specific BHSc (Midwifery) programme.
- c) The required modular credits (or as specified by the other respective faculty) of major core modules for the other degree requirement.
- d) Breadth modules and Discovery Year as specified in the Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulation 2013.

### **8. Declaration of Major**

The choice of either nursing or midwifery major is to be declared at the end of the second semester of candidature.

### **9. Declaration of Double Major**

Double majors are to be declared at the end of the third semester of candidature and is only open to nursing or midwifery major students.

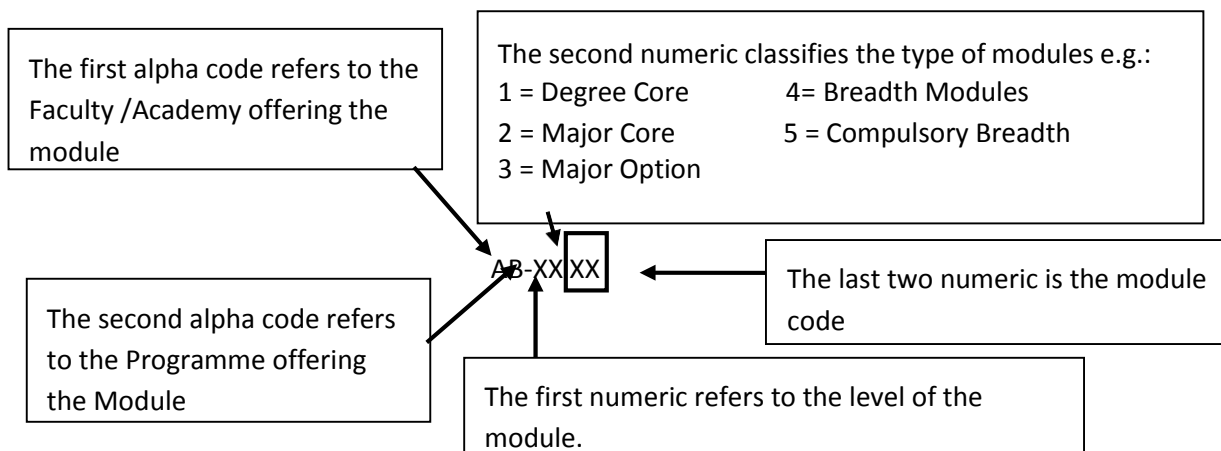
### **10. Module Classification**

<b>Module Type</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Degree Core	These are modules that must be taken by all students enrolled in the Bachelor of Health Science
Major Core	These are modules that are compulsory for all students registered for a particular Major
Major Option	These are optional major modules that contribute to the requirement to complete a major.

Breadth	These are modules which students are free to choose to read to satisfy the breadth requirements to their degree. They can be taken from within the faculty or across faculties.
Compulsory Breadth	These are prescribed breadth modules that are compulsory for all registered university students that contribute to the requirement for graduation from UBD.

## 11. Module Codes

The Module codes have been simplified so that students can track their own programme and numerically ensure that they meet all the requirements for graduation. The Module code uses a 2 alpha, 4 numeric classifications of modules and an alpha suffix to indicate the specialization area.



## 12. Signing Up for Modules

Students will register for modules with their Programme Leader, Academic Advisors and Faculty Assistant Registrar. Students must formally register for modules in order to take the examination.

## 13. Advance Placement credits, exemptions, waivers

Students who transfer from other universities may qualify for exemptions or waivers subject to the Faculty's approval.

Direct entry students are still required to take MIB (or equivalent) if not taken in the last 3 years.

## 14. Discovery Year Programme

Students will undertake a Discovery Year comprised of any one or a combination of study abroad programme (1 – 2 semesters), internships (1-2 semester), community outreach programme (1-2 semester) and/or Innovation or Incubation Projects (1-2 semester) as specified in the Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programme Rules and Regulation August 2013).

#### **15. Academic Advisors**

All academic staff will act as Academic Advisors. Each will be assigned several students where his/her roles and responsibilities include:

- a) Acting as a mentor to the assigned group of students.
- b) Ensuring students take the correct modules in the correct sequence.
- c) Counselling and discussing with students any issues related to academic progress whenever required.
- d) Keeping track of students' progress throughout the whole duration of degree.
- e) Liaising with Dean of student affairs where and when necessary.

#### **16. Assessment**

The students are assessed based on their overall performance through the following aspects:

##### **a) Professional Behaviour**

This is assessed through the students' attitude and behaviour that should be in consistent with the expectation stated in the code of professional conduct for registered nurses and midwives for Brunei Darussalam.

##### **b) Theory**

Students shall take regular Formative Assessments throughout the programme for the information of the student and teachers. The grades obtained at such assessments shall not contribute to decisions concerning progress, although attendance at these assessments is mandatory.

While Summative assessments are those directly contributing to the award of modular credits (MCs) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) and so to progression through the programme.

##### **c) Practice**

The practice of Nursing/Midwifery is assessed through practical skills assessment such as

Objective Structured Clinical Assessment (OSCA) and Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE). OSCA/OSCE are used to assess the students' practical nursing skills. The following are the criteria for passing the OSCA/ OSCE:

- a) The BHSc (Nursing/Midwifery) OSCA/OSCE normally has a range of 5 to 8 stations. Students are required to achieve a total score equal to or above the standard set passing mark for the overall OSCA/OSCE.
- b) In the case where a student achieved an overall mark below the standard set passing mark, the student will be considered as fail.

Students are also assessed in the clinical practice setting using continuous clinical competencies assessment and satisfactorily complete the clinical logbook. Failure to pass in the clinical competency assessment and complete the clinical logbook will result in the student's inability to graduate.

## **17. Examination**

Regulation governing examination on the BHSc (Nursing/Midwifery) programme shall conform to the Universiti Brunei Darussalam Examination Regulation for Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programmes August 2013.

## **18. Absence from Examinations**

The regulations of Absence from Examination stated in the Universiti Brunei Darussalam Examination Regulation For Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programmes August 2013 should apply if a candidate fails to appear for an examination.

## **19. Barring of Students**

- a) Students' attendance at lectures, clinical placement, tutorials / laboratory sessions are compulsory. If a student attendance fail to achieve 90% in clinical placement, problem based learning, case-based learning, tutorial or skill-lab teaching, and/or less than 80% in classroom/lecture, he/she will be barred from taking the examinations for that particular module (For rules and regulations regarding barring of students, please see the University Brunei Darussalam Examination Regulations and Procedure).
- b) The Dean of the PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences may, on the recommendation of the Programme Leader, give recommendation to the examination office to bar candidates from taking the prescribed examination for any module on grounds of unsatisfactory attendance at teaching and practical sessions, unsatisfactory progress in coursework, professional misconduct or any unsafe practices in clinical placement.

## **20. Termination**

- a) The regulations of Transfer between Programmes & Termination of Candidature, stated in the Universiti Brunei Darussalam Examination Regulation for Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programmes August 2013 shall apply to student of this programme.
- b) The student is expected to maintain a high standard of professional behavior commensurate with responsibility as a nurse, at all times. The student must abide by all regulation governing their study at UBD and their development as a professional nurse. In cases where breach of professional conduct is evident, a student can be terminated from the programme. The Dean of PAPRSB Institute of Health Sciences will, on recommendation by Programme Leader, submit a recommendation to terminate student to the Assistant Vice Chancellor (Academic Affairs).
- c) Students who are terminated from the Bachelor of Health Science (Nursing/Midwifery) programme are not allowed to reapply the Bachelor of Health Science programme.

## **21. Parent Regulations**

Any other regulations not mentioned in this document shall conform to the following regulations:

- a) The Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Rules and Regulations August 2013.
- b) Universiti Brunei Darussalam Examination Regulation for Generation Next Undergraduate Degree Programmes August 2013.

## **22. Application of Regulations**

These regulations shall apply to all students registered for the Bachelor in Health Science (Nursing/Midwifery) programme from the 2020 academic year intake onwards (with the exception of clause 2(a) Admission Requirements).
